

St. Philip's School and Community Center 2012-2013 Fee Schedule

The full cost of educating each student at St. Philip's is anticipated to exceed \$12,000 for the 2012-2013 school year. St. Philip's tuition co-pay & fee structure below is designed at a substantially reduced cost per student.

FINANCIAL AID - Financial Aid is available to families who qualify. We encourage you to consider applying if you think that the tuition co-pay would create undue burden on your family. The Financial Aid packet can be obtained from the Admissions office.

NEW STUDENT APPLICATION FEE - \$150 per student due at time application is submitted. The application fee is designed to cover the initial cost of our admissions process for new students, including testing.

ENROLLMENT/RE-ENROLLMENT FEE - \$350 per student due at time of enrollment. Financial Aid is available to families who qualify. The Enrollment Fee is designed to cover the cost of our Admissions and Enrollment process and is in addition to the tuition & fees listed above. A student is not enrolled until the Enrollment fee and completed registration materials are received. In order to provide a quality education, we limit the number of students we accept for each grade level. For re-enrolling students, in the event we receive a student's enrollment fee and completed registration materials after January 13th, the applicant may be placed on a waiting list and will be subject to an increase of \$100 in the enrollment fee.
